Khenchen Palden Sherab Rinpoche (right) is one of the most highly qualified scholars and meditation masters of the Tibetan Buddhist tradition. He entered Gochen Monestary at the age of six, where he began intensive training in all facets of Tibetan Buddhism. He is considered a Master of Dzogchen, the most highly developed tradition of spiritual practice in the Nyingma tradition of Tibetan Buddhism.

Khenpo Tsewang Dongyal Rinposhe (left) is a Tantric Master as well as an accomplished author, poet, and Buddhist historian. His Holiness Dudjom Rinpoche, supreme head of the Nyingma lineage, enthroned him as Abbot of the Nyingma Institute and Orgyen Chokholing Monestary in Kathmandu, Nepal. He is a Tulku, holding all of the transmissions and empowerments of the Nyingma, Kama, and Terma lineages.
