If you could tailor some of your commentary to folks who struggle to 'get it' and structure advice to folks who have 250k+, 100,k+ and or less it would be very helpful.

I have applied your advice as best I can to the extent that I understand it and done the following:

- 1. I have no debt.
- 2. I own rights to occupy a coop apt with modest fees
- 3. I have switched my checking account to a community bank.

I sold stocks and muni bonds through Schwab out of fear. I don't want to use Schwab, Fidelity or Price Waters because I think, but don't know, that they're 'bad guys' (forgive my over simplification-I just don't know how better to evaluate these brokerages.)

Securities custodian, will need someone in system. Not concerned about firms that have large money management and no independent investment banking, trading and derivativies. Provision for 3 month hiccup Index funds – best performance in current environment. Best time to buy – probably summer, late fall.

I don't even know how to look for another brokerage house.

Vanguard has lowest fees – largest promoter of index funds

Bull to bear transfer Global allocations – solve by doing world equity Have to live with volatility

Hi Catherine,

I see your upcoming program on medical care. In the US, the FDA estimated deaths due to adverse drug reactions to be the 4th leading cause of death. I have a publisher interested, but it is scary to step out of the accepted view in today's world.

Catherine,

I just read the special report featuring Edwin Vieira and the convention crisis. In his argument about competitive currencies, the good doctor failed to mention one competing currency that is in existence, US Treasury Notes (the ones with the red ink on them). As far as I can tell about 300 million of these notes are printed every year and under 12 US 411 Federal Reserve Notes can be redeemed in Lawful money upon request (if you could just walk into any Federal Reserve Bank that is). To raise public money the Fed must surrender US Bonds in the said amount to the Treasury in exchange for the public money demanded thus cancelling that same amount of US debt. Private credit is withdrawn and replaced with public money paying off more and more of the public debt.

I'm assuming that Treasury Notes are backed by US gold holdings and that an accounting of said holdings would be critical to the amount of Treasury Notes available. Is this not a viable option??? Could you please ask Dr. Vieira?

Issuing Treasury notes and state and local currencies are all viable legal options. Question is are the viable political options.

I'm trying to find an old Solari interview where you told a story about having a discussion with a friend about learning metabolism. As I remember it you said you were both getting excited about the possibilities afforded by new technologies and increasingly available knowledge, but concluded that only a minority would take advantage of them; dumbing down would continue for the majority. You both wondered what the outcome of this disparity would be, so your friend called up some sort of expert (maybe a mathematician) who could model the problem and predict the outcome. Your friend returned from the phone call depressed because the answer was that it would result in an increase in the rate of entropy. Do you remember telling this story and who the interview was with?

In any case, do you see this entropy in our culture at moment? What risks and opportunities do you see emerging for an information-rich minority while navigating an increasingly chaotic and aggressive majority?

In the 2009 ObamaCare debate, White House aide David Plouffe told nervous Democrats "no bed-wetting," meaning keep calm and all will be well. House Democrats went on lose 63 seats in 2010, but the double irony is that Mr. Plouffe's advice now applies to those reporters and liberals who seem to be invested in the failure of the GOP's version of health-care reform.

Every day brings a new story about Republicans in disarray, the "mirage" of the GOP's reform and the impossibility of change. Donald Trump hasn't been President for even a month, folks. The reality is that Congress is on schedule, progress is underway, and the many potential problems are avoidable.

Behind the scenes, members and staff are being briefed on options and the House will release a consensus proposal after the Presidents Day recess. The details matter and are under discussion, but the outlines are emerging. Congress will use the reconciliation budget maneuver to bypass the Senate filibuster and pass a version of the 2015 repeal bill that President Obama vetoed. This time they'll incorporate as many replacement components as the rules allow to bring more predictability to insurance markets. Leaders are calling this "repeal plus," and it will be followed by more legislation.

The GOP plans to replace ObamaCare's complicated income-based subsidies with a tax credit that floats based on family size and age (a proxy for health status). The credit will be available to anyone who lacks job-based coverage and is ineligible for Medicare or Medicaid. Replacing ObamaCare's central planning with patient-centered choice and flexibility is a priority. So are an expansion of health-savings accounts and high-risk pools for people with pre-existing conditions.

The latest occasion for micro-panic is the House Freedom Caucus's declaration that they may oppose repeal plus. This is lousy politics that would set up the GOP to take the blame for the people hurt by ObamaCare's implosion, which is why there's little support for the strategy in the larger GOP conference. And some Freedom Caucusers are hedging their ultimatum: They say they'll support a bill that's "at least as good as" the 2015 repeal, specifics to come.

The more divisive GOP debate isn't the individual insurance market. It's Medicaid. ObamaCare opened enrollment in this former safety-net program for the poor to all low-income able-bodied adults. This year for the first time the U.S. will now spend more on Medicaid than national defense, but this trajectory is hard to change because ObamaCare created a one-way funding ratchet.

Medicaid is jointly financed by the federal government and states, and the feds paid about 60% on average under the old system. That arrangement still exists, but ObamaCare paid a 100% "match" for the newly eligible to induce states to expand. This rate is never supposed to phase down lower than 90%.

That means ObamaCare's new beneficiaries are far more fiscally valuable to states than Medicaid's original purpose: the most vulnerable women, children and individuals with disabilities. Some overspending states like Connecticut have even cut benefits for the poor rather than give up the ObamaCare windfall.

If Republicans were to restore Medicaid's priorities or downsize eligibility, about 14 million people could lose coverage, but the larger problem is that Governors would face a larger hole in their budgets. Medicaid's major provider constituents—hospitals—are also politically powerful. The 2015 repeal bill phased out the Medicaid expansion over two years, but Republicans may need to forgo immediate cuts to avoid Senate defections. The more important goal is to change the incentives over the long term and eliminate the perverse formulas that discount the welfare of the truly needy.

A helpful revolution in Medicaid would be to end the match rate that rewards higher spending and move to block grants. States would get some fixed pot of money annually, determined by how many people are enrolled. The pots might be expensive in the early years, but states would become accountable for marginal per capita spending growth over time. Governors can be assuaged by ending Medicaid's command-and-control regulatory model, freeing them to use new tools to control costs.

The Foundation for Government Accountability has proposed a temporary enrollment freeze for new Medicaid, which is a shrewd idea. No new applications for the expansion would be approved, and gradually enrollment would fall as people naturally move up the income ladder and qualify out. The goal isn't to strip people from the rolls but to ensure that fewer people need to be dependant on government.

Health and Human Services Secretary Tom Price has been conducting a goodwill tour of Capitol Hill, but presidential leadership is needed to defuse the tensions and resolve the policy debates. Meantime, if Republicans were moving faster the stories would be about recklessness and human disregard. Careful, deliberative governing is what Americans are

supposed to want from Congress.
