These regimes pose a threat to our international corporate values." Sir Evelyn, a billionaire financier who is married to Lynn Forester de Rothschild, did not explain why world governments should listen to his demands for interventionist wars in the Middle-East.

However it has been suggested he is advocating for the **invasion of Syria** because the nation remains one of only five nations left in the world that does not have a <u>Rothschild</u> controlled central bank.

In the year 2000 there were eight countries without a Rothschild controlled central bank, however Iraq, Libya and Afghanistan – immediately after western invasion – now all have established **central banks**.

And he said, "I guess if the only tool you have is a hammer, every problem has to look like a nail."

So I came back to see him a few weeks later, and by that time we were bombing in Afghanistan. I said, "Are we still going to war with Iraq?" And he said, "Oh, it's worse than that." He reached over on his desk. He picked up a piece of paper. And he said, "I just got this down from upstairs" -- meaning the Secretary of Defense's office -- "today." And he said, "This is a memo that describes how we're going to take out seven countries in five years, starting with Iraq, and then Syria, Lebanon, Libya, Somalia, Sudan and, finishing off, Iran." I said, "Is it classified?" He said, "Yes, sir." I said, "Well, don't show it to me." And I saw him a year or so ago, and I said, "You remember that?" He said, "Sir, I didn't show

you that memo! I didn't show it to you!"

#### Paulson to Leave A.I.G. Board

The hedge fund billionaire John A. Paulson is leaving the board of American International Group, the insurance giant

said in a filing on Thursday. Mr. Paulson had joined Carl C. Icahn in pushing for a breakup of the company before they were given seats on the board. But Mr. Paulson's hedge fund, which once had a 1 percent stake in A.I.G., has been selling off its shares in the company.

With Mr. Paulson's departure and the retirement of two other directors, George L. Miles Jr and Robert S. Miller, the board of A.I.G. will shrink to 13 from 16. The A.I.G. board's chief task will be selecting a successor to Peter D. Hancock, who announced last month that he <u>would resign as chief</u> <u>executive</u>. The company also said in its proxy filing that Mr. Hancock would not receive a bonus award for 2016.

### Goldman Sachs: space-mining for platinum is 'more realistic than perceived'


Goldman Sachs is bullish on space mining with "asteroid-grabbing spacecraft." In a 98-page note for clients seen by Business Insider, analyst Noah Poponak and his team argue that platinum mining in space is getting cheaper and easier, and the rewards are becoming greater as time goes by.

"While the psychological barrier to mining asteroids is high, the actual financial and technological barriers are far lower. Prospecting probes can likely be built for tens of millions of dollars each and Caltech has suggested an asteroid-grabbing spacecraft could cost \$2.6bn," the report says.

\$2.6 billion (£2 billion) sounds like a lot, but it is only about one-third the amount that has been invested in Uber, putting the price well within reach of today's VC funds. It is also a comparable to the setup cost for a regular earthbound mine. (This MIT paper estimates a new rare earth metal mine can cost up to \$1 billion, from scratch.)

The price of spacecraft is plummeting, thanks to reusable rockets from Elon Musk's SpaceX and Jeff Bezos's Blue Origin. It used to cost \$35 million (£28 million) to send one person up on a Soyuz rocket. Today, Virgin Galactic hopes to get space tourists into space for something like \$250,000 (£200,000), Goldman says. More broadly, the price of all new rockets is falling over time:

Those economics make going into space more feasible. The rewards would be vast: just one asteroid might contain \$50 billion (£40 billion) of platinum:

"Space mining could be more realistic than perceived. Water and platinum group metals that are abundant on asteroids are highly disruptive from a technological and economic standpoint. Water is easily converted into rocket fuel, and can even be used unaltered as a propellant. Ultimately being able to stockpile the fuel in LEO [low earth orbit] would be a game changer for how we access space. And platinum is platinum. According to a 2012 Reuters interview with Planetary Resources, a single asteroid the size of a football field could contain \$25bn-\$50bn worth of platinum."

There is just one problem: That same asteroid would instantly tank the entire platinum market: "Successful asteroid mining would likely crater the global price of platinum, with a single 500-meter-wide asteroid containing nearly 175X the global output, according to MIT's Mission 2016."

Nonetheless, Goldman is bullish. "We expect that systems could be built for less than that given trends in the cost of manufacturing spacecraft and improvements in technology. Given the capex of mining operations on Earth, we think that financing a space mission is not outside the realm of possibility."

The question we ask in our 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Wrap Up is "Can a new administration preserve a prosperous economy without more debt, crime and war?" The question is steadily being answered with a resounding "No!"

The budget blueprint published by the President in March suggested that everyone would be pleased with more money – both the factions that want to keep the global empire going and the factions that want instead to rebuild American infrastructure and the core US Army – by simply throwing more money at the Department of Defense. The blueprint has no mention of the \$11.5 trillion missing from the Department of Defense, including \$6.5 trillion missing in fiscal 2015. Apparently, the new administration wants to continue the practice of spending money outside of Constitutional requirements and in violation of the laws related to financial management.

However, this imperial budget leaves no money for health care or, for that matter, for anything else. Expect the actual May budget submission to make for fascinating reading. Please read our 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Wrap Up presentation on the

Trump administration to understand the important issues – all of which the corporate media ignore.

This week Secretary of State Rex Tillerson reversed his position that Assad could stay, and the President ordered air strikes on Syria, claiming that Assad is responsible for alleged chemical weapons used in an attack on the rebel-held town of Khan Sheikhoun in Idlib Province of Syria on Tuesday.

[I'm with Ron Paul: There is zero chance that Assad would have used chemical weapons deliberately.]

Steve Bannon was removed from the National Security Council this week. Steve is the guy who helped craft the inaugural message: "We will seek friendship and goodwill with the nations of the world – but we do so with the understanding that it is the right of all nations to put their own interests first. We do not seek to impose our way of life on anyone, but rather to let it shine as an example for everyone to follow."

Moving onto the National Security Council as Bannon was exiting was Goldman Sachs partner Dina Powell, who had used her Arab heritage and language skills in the Bush administration to help Condoleeza Rice engineer Middle Eastern wars that have killed over 1,000,000 Arabs. Powell's appointment followed the President's meeting on Friday with Rice, now a partner in <u>RiceHadleyGates</u>, <u>LLC</u>.

At the same time, the President's son-in-law Jared Kushner joined Marine General Joseph Dunford, the chairman of the US Joint Chiefs of Staff in meetings with US military advisors in Iraq.

While ordering air strikes against Syria, President Trump described the inhumanity of using chemical weapons on one's own people. He did not mention how the use of chemical weapons in US-sponsored global spraying, vaccines, and narcotics trafficking likely killed more Americans this week than numbered in any of the various alleged Syrian death counts. Although the use of chemical weapons in Syria, and Assad's responsibility has not yet been documented or proved, the chemical assault of the American government on its own people has been documented and proven repeatedly. Millions of people voted for Trump in the hope that he would stop US government chemical assaults on the American people.

Events in Syria likely have more to do with the EU approval last week of the Nordstrom pipeline with Russia than with our concern for the rights of the Syrian people. America is still using its post-9/11 strategy to make war on 7 countries as described by General Wesley Clark. With the approval of the Nordstrom pipeline, the feasibility of the Qatar-Turkey pipeline with transit through Syria becomes urgent. This is not just pipeline politics, however. The primacy of the US dollar as reserve currency depends on energy dominance.

However, President Trump would be wise to remember the words of General Colin Powell, "You break it, you own it."

Hi Catherine,

I am a naturopath and entrepreneur. In 2008, I discovered you on Youtube and have been listening ever since; recently I become a subscriber and have been listening to your reports the last few months.

As a listener, I have a better understanding about what is going on then the average person. As a naturopath, I am familiar with GMO's, vaccine toxicity and medical suppression. I was extremely relived when Trump was elected, that said, the more I listen to you the more I feel frustrated about what is going on and slightly despondent.

#### Hi Catherine:

Thank you for sharing your brain via your website and doing interviews with Greg Hunter; I have found your reporting and commentary to be uniquely insightful and illuminating.

I live an hour outside of Pittsburgh in Ligonier, PA (between the two mountain ranges to the east of Pittsburgh; our version of Galt's Gulch I suppose).

We our observing extraordinary levels of geoengineering in our skies. Essentially, jets are "spraying" in grid patterns day and night. During heavy spraying, we observe "fallout" in our ground level atmosphere (the particles appear to be reflective as the fallout presents to the human eye as light flashes darting about as would "excited" particles in a gaseous medium). The spraying has come to dominate our local climate; I cannot remember the last time I observed direct sunlight or a natural sky ... it is surreal.

The FAA has informed me via a phone conversation that: "the planes spraying in grid patterns are the US military". I have yet to receive a response to my inquiries from the US military as you might imagine.



Watch List: April 12, 2017

### **Watch List**

The items listed below represent potential emerging issues that our analysts are tracking. These can be long term or short term, but will be updated daily. If an item on our Watch List becomes critical, we will email you a full analysis explaining its significance.

Each Saturday, we will follow up our daily Watch List for each week with our conclusions on these issues.

- China-North Korea: After yesterday's reports of troop movements by the People's Liberation Army, China's Ministry of Defense issued a terse denial of the specifics of those reports. More importantly, Chinese President Xi Jinping and U.S. President Donald Trump spoke on the telephone, with Xi reportedly emphasizing the need for a peaceful denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula. That the two leaders would need to speak again so soon after meeting in person and with a U.S. carrier battle group on its way to the Korean Peninsula, stopping in the East China Sea for an exercise with Japan's Maritime Self-Defense Force is somewhat ominous and may indicate that China is worried about an impending U.S. strike. This remains on internal watch.
- North Korea: On Tuesday, the North Korean Supreme People's Assembly reinstated and convened the

- Diplomatic Commission. Created in 1989 and abolished in 1998, the Diplomatic Commission is supposedly responsible for handling issues related to foreign affairs. Re-establishing this body could mean a change in who is managing the day-to-day affairs of North Korea's external relations. If so, it could be an indication of future North Korean foreign relations. We will study the history of this commission and watch for anything suggesting a change in North Korean behavior.
- Russia-Japan: Media reported on April 11 that Russia flew two Tu-95 strategic bombers into the Sea of Japan, causing Japan to scramble two fighter jets to confront the planes and advise them to turn back. Russia responded by scrambling two Il-38 fighters and sending them to accompany the bombers near the island of Hokkaido. Later that day, Russia sent two Tu-142 antisubmarine planes into the same area. We need to understand if Russia's planes actually crossed into Japanese sovereign territory and how long it took Russia's fighters to arrive on the scene. We should also examine prior circumstances in which Russia sent fighters to accompany its bombers.
- Belarus: Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko and Russian President Vladimir Putin had a telephone conversation about implementing agreements reached at an April 3 meeting in St. Petersburg. Russia made concessions regarding Belarus, with Putin agreeing to refinance Belarus' debt. He also agreed to renew 24 million tons a year of oil supplies to Belarus and promised Gazprom would give Belarus discounts on gas supplies in 2018 and 2019. In exchange, Belarus will pay

back its debt of more than \$720 million for gas supplies. Considering the amount of concessions Russia made to Belarus, the question of exactly what Russia is buying in Belarus becomes most important to understand. Answering that question requires a good understanding of the stability of the Belarusian economy.
