agreement and met in Seattle on April 30. They discussed strategic possibilities, but an offer wasn't made.

Whole Foods reached out to Albertsons to schedule a meeting but remained in contact with Amazon.

They also received an inquiry from undisclosed "Company Y."

Amazon met with
Albertsons on May 18.
They told Whole Foods
that a possible acquisition
would value the company
between \$35 and \$40 per
share. Later that day they
had a conversation with
"Company Y," but did not
discuss an offer.

By May 23, Amazon made an offer for \$41 per share to buy Whole Foods. In the letter, it said they "reserved the right to terminate discussions if there was any leak or rumor of its interest in acquiring the company."

On June 1, Whole Foods told Amazon they agreed to the deal and the due diligence process was underway. The transaction documents were completed by June 15 and the merger was announced June 16.

The \$13.7 billion deal was the first time Amazon even made a purchase over \$1 billion. Amazon's \$970 million purchase of Twitch was their largest previous deal.

The acquisition suggests that Amazon is committed to building out its grocery business. They had already been making deliveries through Amazon Fresh and had begun introducing brickand-mortar stores. There are undoubtedly synergies between these efforts and Whole Foods.

But while the deal has been announced, it has not yet closed. Pending regulatory approval, the deal will be completed later this year.


