Good News:

President Trump is ending a covert CIA operation to arm and train

Syrian rebels fighting against President Bashar al-Assad, something Russia has long desired, according to a Wednesday report in the Washington Post.

The Obama administration introduced the operation in 2013, as a part of its efforts to push Assad out of power, and its effectiveness has come into question even among its backers. But the timing of the decision raises questions for the White House, as it fends off accusations that the president and his team obscured his **interactions with Russian President Vladimir Putin** at the G-20 summit in Hamburg, Germany, earlier this month.

On Tuesday, the White House admitted the president had a previously undisclosed discussion with Russian President Vladimir Putin over dinner at the G-20. White House deputy press secretary Sarah Huckabee Sanders on Wednesday declined to tell reporters during a briefing what Putin and Mr. Trump discussed. The White House is also working to explain the growing list of attendees at the **June 2016 meeting Donald Trump Jr. held** with a Russian lawyer and others at Trump Tower.

Russia has been critical of U.S. efforts to punish Assad, particularly after the deadly chemical attack Assad carried out on his own people in April. Mr. Trump retaliated against that attack by ordering a missile launch on a Syrian airbase.

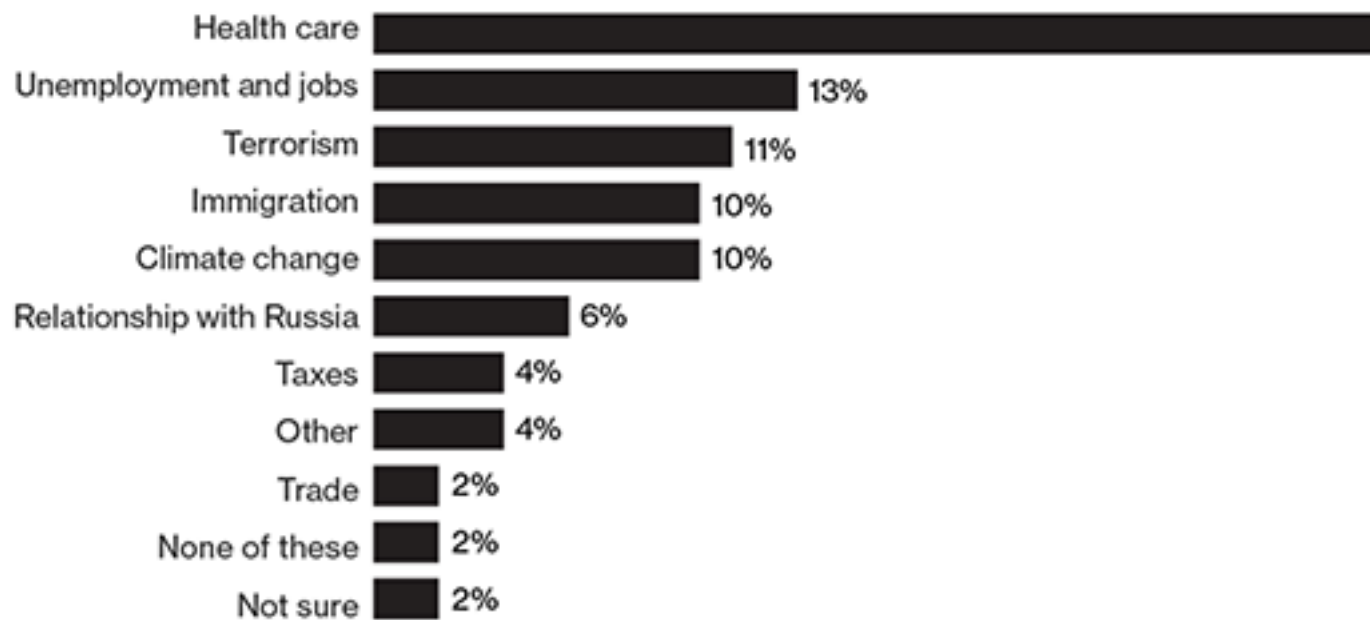
Mr. Trump struck a deal with Russia at the G-20 summit on a ceasefire in southwest Syria. Mr. Trump said the deal was a benefit of working with Moscow.

[What Americans Care About vs. What the Media Cares About](#)

Bloomberg released a poll Monday in which they gauged Americans' mood six months into the new presidency. While Trump didn't fare too well, Americans are quite optimistic about the economy in general and their personal financial health. As part of the study, Bloomberg asked respondents what they think is the top issue facing the country. [Here are the results:](#)

Not surprisingly, health care tops the list of concerns, followed by jobs and security issues. These findings are pretty typical, though the collapse of Obamacare and the GOP bills to fix it have caused health care to surge higher than usual. But look toward the center of the list. Russia, the issue that has dominated press coverage since

the November election, scores a paltry 6 percent on Americans' top concerns.

This lack of interest reminded me of a June 27 Media Research Center [survey](#) in which they calculated the amount of network news coverage of major issues. The results were radically different than the Bloomberg chart above:

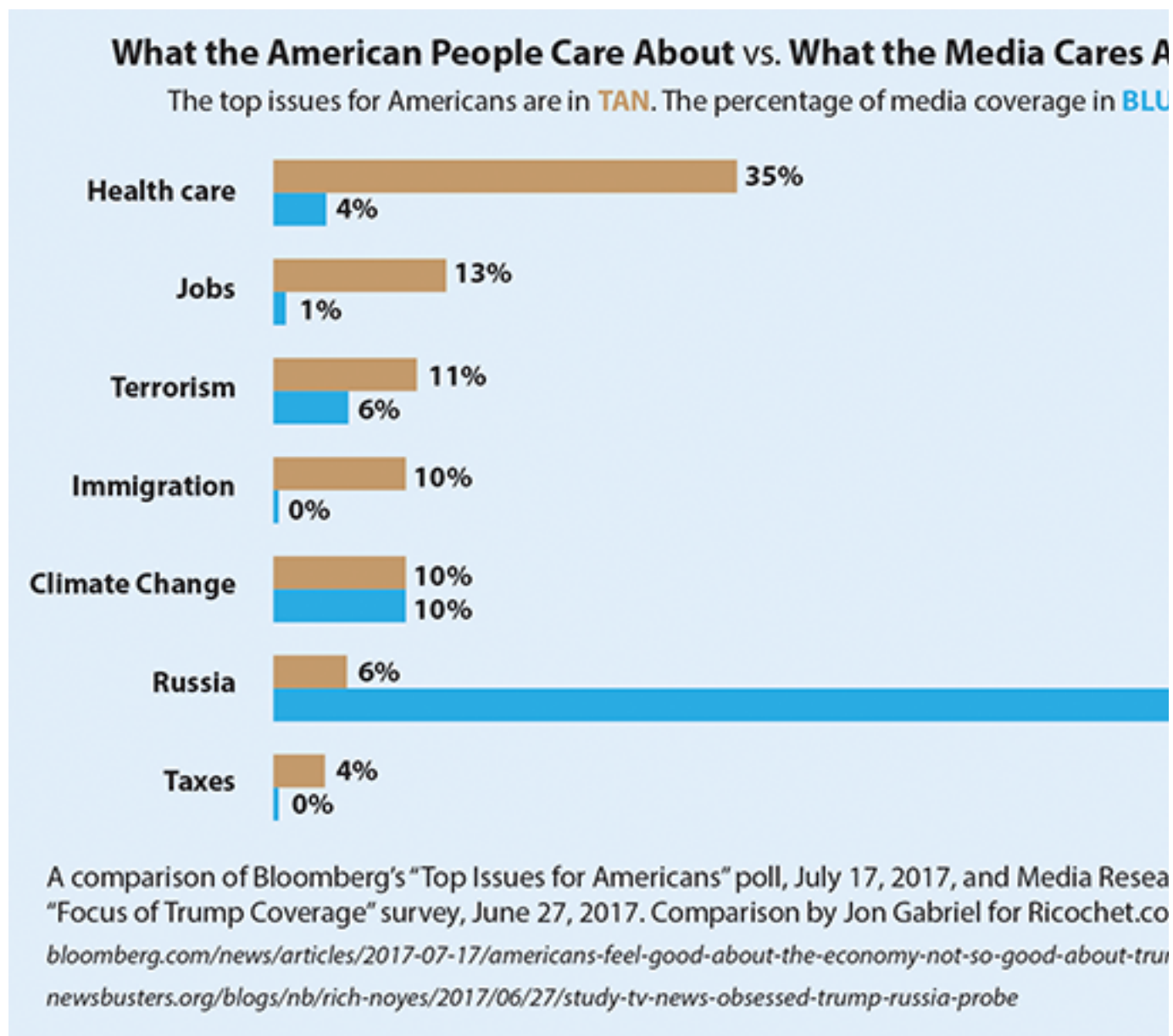

Despite the American people caring far more about health care than any other issue, the media has swamped the airwaves with Trump/Russia conspiracies to the detriment of nearly everything else.

The difference between the people and the press was so jarring, I created a chart comparing the two studies. Granted, these studies were conducted by two different organizations using very different methods, but the juxtaposition was remarkable.

I totaled the time in the MRC study (469 min.) and calculated the percentage of time each issue was given. I then compared the percentage of media coverage on each issue to the percentages shown as Americans' top issues:



Just 6 percent of Americans think Russia is the top issue, yet nightly newscasts devoted 75 percent of their airtime to the story. Meanwhile, Americans' biggest concern, health care, only garnered 4 percent of the major networks' total coverage.

The media have shown how drastically out of step they are with their own audience. If they want to earn back their hemorrhaging Nielsen numbers, perhaps they can spend time on something other than Russia Russia Russia.

The \$600bn question Donald Trump has talked big about his military build up

SPEAKING in the White House Rose Garden in May, Donald Trump described the \$19.9bn increase in defence spending for 2017 (agreed upon seven months late after much wrangling) as “massive and badly needed”. It would soon be followed, he promised, by further boosts to the Pentagon’s funding. “We’re going to have the finest equipment of all types—whether it’s aeroplanes, or ships or equipment in general—that we’ve ever had in the history of our country,” he said. Mr Trump has promised to expand the navy from 275 ships to 350, the army from 476,000 active-duty soldiers to 540,000 and to give the air force hundreds of additional fighter jets.

As Jim Mattis, the defence secretary, and General Joseph Dunford, chairman of the joint chiefs of staff, went in to fight for next year’s defence budget before a clutch of congressional committees, a different picture emerged. The president’s budget request for fiscal 2018, which begins in October, has been pitched at \$603bn (with a base budget for the Pentagon of \$575bn). That is \$54bn above the caps mandated by the 2011 Budget Control Act (BCA), which started to bite in 2013, but only 3.3%, above Barack Obama’s defence plans.

The increase has to cover two spending lines in the 2017 budget passed by Congress that were higher than the Obama request: 16,000 additional troops for the army, and a 2.1% pay increase instead of 1.6%. About half the extra \$19bn would thus be absorbed by the extra personnel costs and the higher operational and maintenance costs that are the consequence of a larger force. In terms of equipment, it will mean one more destroyer ordered, but

not a single extra aircraft above the Obama request. Mr Mattis admitted to the House Armed Services Committee on June 12th that the budget submitted would not go far beyond “filling in holes”. By that he meant improving what he sees as the poor state of readiness resulting from four years of budget caps, sequestration (automatic across-the-board cuts when the caps were exceeded) and continuing resolutions (to meet funding needs when Congress could not reach a longer-term agreement). “Congress as a whole has met the present challenge with lassitude, not leadership,” he said.

The Republican leaders of the House and Senate Armed Services Committees, Mac Thornberry and John McCain agree, and also regard Mr Trump’s budget request as inadequate. They compare the plight of the armed services today with the post-Vietnam “hollow force” of the 1970s, and would like to see a base budget this year of \$640bn, rising to \$740bn by 2022. Mr McCain wants \$60bn allocated annually to cover “overseas contingency operations” (OCO). He rightly complains that the money for this, which should be largely for fighting current wars, has been abused as a slush fund to get around the budget caps.

There is slim chance that the \$603bn requested by the president will materialise, let alone the larger military build-up envisaged by Senators McCain and Thornberry. Defence will get more only if non-defence discretionary spending gets less, says Todd Harrison of the Centre for Strategic and International Studies, a think-tank. The president’s budget already banks deep cuts elsewhere, especially to the State Department, overseas aid and the Environmental Protection Agency. The only way to get even close to Mr Trump’s budget request would be to repeal or amend the BCA. Repeal seems improbable—Mr Trump’s budget director, Mick Mulvaney, is a deficit hawk who loves it. But after a summer

of legislative gridlock, there may eventually be a compromise amendment of the kind that has passed three times before. Mr Harrison reckons defence will end up getting only a few billion dollars more than Mr Obama wanted. “This is not”, he says, “a defence build-up.”

Nor are subsequent years likely to be different. Mr Mattis talks hopefully about 3-5% a year “top-line” growth. “In Washington, you have to get your big increases in early when you have political capital,” says Mackenzie Eaglen of the American Enterprise Institute, another think-tank. Unfortunately for Mr Trump, many in Congress believe he has already exhausted what little capital he started out with.

Does this matter? Michael O’Hanlon of the Brookings Institution likes bits of the McCain/Thornberry plan, but he questions their claims of a “huge readiness crisis”. Mr O’Hanlon notes that “the military is not in dire straits”, and that Congress “should be pushing harder to see what the services can do to manage the force better”. The present strain could be eased by reducing expensive rotational deployments to places such as South Korea, Okinawa (Japan) and Poland, in favour of longer tours with families in tow. Ships could stay on station for several years if one crew relieved another every six months, making a much bigger navy unnecessary.

Including overseas contingency funding, this year’s defence budget, adjusted for inflation, will actually be slightly higher than the peak of the much-vaunted Reagan build-up (see chart). It is true that today’s all-volunteer force has become more expensive and that costs such as health care absorb more of the budget. It is also true that automatic spending cuts have hampered planning and resulted in

some dysfunction. But with a little more creativity at the Pentagon, \$600bn or so could still be made to go quite a long way.

HACKER STEALS MORE THAN \$7 MILLION IN DIGITAL CURRENCY BY SWITCHING A MERE LINK

WHY IT MATTERS TO YOU

On the internet, digital currency is just as valuable as real world cash, so users of Bitcoin and Ether must be just as careful about making online transactions.

[Security firm Tripwire reports](#) that a hacker managed to steal more than \$7 million in digital currency by simply replacing a single link. The hack took place on Monday during an event called an Initial Coin Offering (ICO) to reel in investors of a cryptocurrency app called CoinDash. However, early investors quickly discovered that a link for depositing digital currency on the CoinDash website was not legitimate.

According to Tripwire, trading platform CoinDash began its ICO at 1 p.m. (GMT). Three minutes later, investors figured out that the link for sending Ether, a type of digital currency, was taking them to the wrong deposit location. Within those three minutes, the hacker managed to accumulate more than \$7 million before CoinDash terminated the ICO and removed the page.

“The moment the token sale went public, the CoinDash website was hacked and a malicious address replaced the CoinDash Token Sale address,” CoinDash said. “As a result, more than 2,000 investors sent ETH to the malicious address. The stolen ETH amounted to a total of 37,000 ETH.”



Ether is the digital currency of the world's second most popular [cryptocurrency](#) network, [Ethereum](#). This platform consists of smart contracts, which are essentially bits of code that will execute when certain requirements are fulfilled. These “apps” are listed on the Ethereum network using what is called a blockchain, which serves as a registry that records all transactions. Ether, abbreviated as ETH, is what's used to pay for things and services listed on the Ethereum network.

So why not just use real world cash? Because digital currency is decentralized. It's not managed by banks or the government. Plus, both the merchant and buyer can remain completely anonymous,

with a transaction digitally signed and verified by [an unknown miner](#) on the associated network. Ether is similar to [Bitcoin](#) in purpose although technically they are completely different digital currencies. Individuals who successfully participated in a private “heads up” for whitelist contributors 15 minutes prior to the public ICO received “tokens” as proof of their CoinDash app investment. However, those who invested Ether using the hacked address are reportedly now demanding a refund. After all, the CoinDash website was not locked down tight, enabling a hacker to insert a simple link that collected millions in stolen digital currency.

However, many Ether users reportedly flocked to social networks and [questioned the theft](#). Was this a genuine hack, or a simple scam using a hack as a cover story? As Tripwire states, there is no evidence to suggest foul play.

CoinDash is currently providing [an online form](#) for victims to complete as part of the company’s forensic investigation into the hack. Victims are asked to provide their email address, wallet address, a proven transaction number, and the amount of Ether sent.

“This was a damaging event to both our contributors and our company but it is surely not the end of our project,”

CoinDash added. “We are looking into the security breach and will update you all as soon as possible about the findings. We are still under attack. Please do not send any ETH to any address, as the Token Sale has been terminated.”

Despite the hack, CoinDash said that it managed to secure \$6.4 million from early contributors and whitelist participants in the 15-minute “heads up” prior to the ICO. Those who sent digital currency to the wrong Ether address during the hack will still receive tokens. Otherwise, investors who sent Ether to the wrong address after CoinDash removed the ICO page will not receive investment tokens.

Thank you to you and your amazing Solari team for continuing to be a beacon of light!

Californians are mostly unaware that a bill is quickly and quietly moving through the state legislature, which would strip local governments' control and power to deny permits to install 5G microwave transmitters most anywhere - on municipal utility poles, street lights and traffic signals, regardless of how close they may be to homes, businesses, schools, within scenic viewsheds, etc. It also discusses how the telecom companies would greatly reduce and cap the rent that could be charged for the transmitters.

It does not mention the serious and dangerous health effects of blanketing California with 5G wireless radiation, nor does it touch on the FCC's attempt to remove the copper wires that enable land lines - the FCC's intention is get rid of land lines and go entirely with cell phones.

The small town of Nevada City was the only city in all of California that sent city representatives to Sacramento to speak up against this bill - not once, but four times, including four different city representatives. It is important to note that the exemption of historic districts to this draconian bill made it into the SB-649, 100% due to Nevada City's advocacy.

One of the big concerns about the rollout of this 5G, is that citizens (not just in California, but across the country as well) would no longer have the ability to get away from the microwave radiation. The intent is to blanket the country, for the benefit of driverless cars, virtual reality, and numerous other uses. Currently, individuals and families to choose not to eat GMO foods, and make other decisions that affect their health. However this would all change in relation to protecting oneself and one's

family from 5G - with this bill, we would no longer be able to protect ourselves or get away from the damaging radiation.
